When I get there I will go to the lobby and meet **Park Ranger Julia**, who will get me ready to take my adventure. I might have to wait for my turn at the adventure and I can do some fun things while I wait. There will be **music**. I can sing some **songs** and clap my hands. I will see other people waiting there too. My friends will come out to the lobby to meet me and take me to the adventure.

I hope we will catch **fireflies** on the journey because it would be fun. If we do catch them, we will get to hold them in a jar and look at them. I can say "yes" if I want to hold the jar of **fireflies** or "no" if I do not want to hold the jar of **fireflies**.
